<p>Can I ask the panel when will the vaccination be available to healthcare support workers and staff? I work for Navigo Extra and we go into service users' homes and some are Covid positive. Some staff are also vulnerable.</p>	<p>Navigo will hopefully be able to support vaccination of staff soon. We are developing a centralised list of health and social care staff to make sure we give everyone the offer of a vaccine before 15/2/21.</p>
<p>What is ICS please?</p>	<p>Hi there, this is Integrated Care System.</p>
<p>Not a question, just a massive well done and thank you to all frontline healthcare staff, and all those who are coordinating behind the scenes to keep those staff and their patients as safe and well as possible. <p>Sounds really great regarding vaccinations. But how will you vaccinate people who have no access to transport, anyone to help them and are not on a bus route?</p>	<p>If patients are housebound and can't get to a vaccination centre we have now started using the AstraZenica Oxford vaccine to do home visits and administer the vaccine. We have only just started to receive the AstraZenica vaccine and have been prioritising the small care homes (we were using the pfizer vaccine for the large care homes)</p>
<p>Are there any plans to have a 24hr vaccination capability - assuming there are no issues with the availability of the vaccine?</p>	<p>We will keep it under consideration. We think the limiting factor for rate of vaccination will be how many doses we receive per week. We are currently working 7 days per week up to 8pm. we will do whatever it takes to make sure we use the vaccine we receive as quickly as possible.</p>
<p>Will the Trust look at allowing patients to take prescriptions to any chemist when they are being discharged from A&amp;E, rather than having to use the internal pharmacist? It will save a lot of time and reduce having to return the next day when they do not have that medication in stock or availability, it will reduce people entering the hospital unnecessarily?</p>	<p>Thank you for your question, we review the prescribing and dispensing of medications regularly. As part of this we do consider access to alternatives to dispensing. We do offer an alternative to the hospital pharmacy especially for out of hours, but I appreciate this may not always be convenient for everyone. I will take back your question to our team for them to consider going forward.</p>
<p>You mentioned the target for vaccinating over 50s and anyone over 16 with a long-term medical condition by end of March. What is plan for vaccinating anyone under 50 without a medical condition?</p>	<p>At the moment people under 50 without a medical condition would be next with a program of moving through by age</p>
